## **BRIJENDRA SHEKHAR WELFARE SCHEME-Updated**

**INTRODUCTION:** CEC ATC Guild India launched BSWS scheme in remembrance of our beloved veteran leader Late Shri Brijendra Shekhar effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021.

Brijendra Shekhar Welfare Scheme (BSWS), is the revolutionary step for our ATC Guild India membership to provide financial assistance to the family of deceased ATC Guild member by ATC Guild (I) members. ATC Guild (India) extend our gratitude to our membership for such an overwhelmed response for this scheme.

**DETAILS OF BSWS FUND:** BSWS has proved highly beneficial for the families of our beloved colleagues who lost their lives. We lost total 8 colleagues since the day BSWS was launched and out of 8 only 4 were Bonafide members of BSWS and it was very helpful for these families during the time of hardship. A total of Rs. 80 lacs has been given as an Ex-Gratia to the grieved families.

*Total BSWS Members: 2119*

*Total Collection: Rs. 1,13,57,000*

Volunteer Collection from BSWS Members: Rs. 63,57,000

CEC Contribution from Ephemeral Fund: Rs. 50,00,000

Ex-Gratia Amount Paid/ Approved: Rs. 80,00,000

BALANCE: Rs. 33,57,000

It has been more than a year since the scheme was launched and BSWS trust decided to update the scheme to make it comprehensive and it is as mentioned below:

**Note:** The felicitation to the ATC Guild member on superannuation day is discontinued as CEC and BSWS Trust decided to facilitate the ATC Guild Members from CEC Fund only.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All members of ATC Guild India with their membership status current up to the previous quarter will be eligible for this scheme. For eligibility the following points are to be taken care of:

1. Participant shall be a member of ATC Guild India with all dues cleared up to the previous quarter from the date of claim.
2. All non-members who want to participate in BSWS shall become ATC Guild member by clearing all their dues maximum by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022.

3. A person shall pay all latest contribution requests generated by CEC for fund recoupment to be the beneficiary of this scheme. Failing in paying the contribution for fund recoupment will result in non-subscription to BSW Scheme automatically.

**BSWS FUND RECOUPMENT:** Presently, BSWS corpus fund will be having a minimum of 1 crore which can cater up to 5 untimely demises of ATC Guild member. Once CEC pays out for 3 demises i.e., payment of 60 lacs to beneficiaries, the fund will be recouped by collecting 60 lacs from membership based on the demand raised by CEC for member's contribution.

The recoupment amount will be decided by the formula given below:

***"BSWS Recoupment Amount = (1 CRORE – BALANCE OF BSWS CORPUS FUND) ÷ Number of BSWS Members. "***

As the total amount of Rs. 6,000,000 has been paid to the grieved family of BSWS members and an amount Rs. 2,000,000 has been approved by BSWS Trust to be given to the family of our beloved member Late Shri Ramvir, DGM(ATM), Nagpur Airport.

And it was resolved in CEC/BSWS meetings to initiate the Recoupment process for the BSWS Fund to recoup the BSWS corpus Fund to 1 Crore Rupees.

***Individual Contribution of 3200, (which include Rs.3137.25 as recoupment amount calculated by above mentioned formula and Rs. 62.74 as processing fees) to be deposited latest by 31th July 2022 by BSWS Members.***

**JOINING PROCESS:** BSWS trust resolved in the BSWS Trust Meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2022 that an ATC whose date of joining AAI is 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 or earlier and did not join the BSWS initially, can join BSWS during:

**The BSWS Recoupment Process Only:** By registering themselves for the BSWS and paying the **BSWS Recoupment Amount (e.g Rs. 3200 till 31<sup>st</sup> July 2022)** as decided by above mentioned formula in BSWS Recoupment section and a nominal **Registration Fee of Rs.500.** (Total Rs. 3700 till 31<sup>st</sup> July 2022)

The Registration fees will be waived off for newly recruited Air Traffic Controller who joins the ATC Guild(I) and BSWS during first BSWS Recoupment process after their date of joining AAI.

(a new recruited ATC has to join ATC Guild(I) and BSWS together to get BSWS registration fees Waived off)

**Note: It was resolved by BSWS Trust that once the BSWS Recoupment Process is over i.e., after 31<sup>st</sup> July 2022, No New request to join BSWS will be considered till the next BSWS Recoupment Process is initiated except the request is by a newly recruited ATC.**

**PROCEDURE FOR CLAIM IN CASE OF DEMISE:** The claim settlement in case of demise of an ATC Guild member will be through following procedure:

1. Branch Secretary will send the details of deceased member to CEC along with the certification of current membership and details of contribution pay out to the Scheme.
2. The details of beneficiary sent by Branch secretary shall be ratified by Regional Secretary.
3. Regional Secretary will send the ratified details of member to BSWs Committee which consists the following members
  - I. Two nominees from CEC
  - II. All Regional Secretaries
4. Once received, CEC will approve the release of Rs.20 lacs based on committee recommendations.

**CUSTODIAN OF FUND:** The authorized signatories as per ATC Guild India Constitution will be the custodian of the BSWs fund.

**DISPUTE RESOLUTION:** In case of any dispute, the decision of Central Executive Council will be final.
